## Abbreviated Terms

- Undergraduate (UG) / Graduate (GR or GRAD) / Juris Doctor (JD)
- Post-Baccalaureate (Post-Bacc) / Early College High School (ECHS)
- School Credit Hour (SCH)

## Campus Statistic

**Academic Plan** – The academic program associated to the student.

Values: DACCT-BBA, DPSYC-BA, DCRJS-BS, DGNBU-BBA, etc.

**Admit Type** – Admission categories used for reporting which reflect a student’s status upon entry in the specified term/semester.

Values: First Time in College (FTIC), Continuing, New UG Trans, New GRAD, Transient, etc.

**Class** - Student level of last application available for a given fall admit term.

Values: Freshman, Sophomore, Junior, Senior, Master’s, Doctoral.

**Ethnicity** – Based on IPEDS ethnicity classification.

Values: American Indian or Alaskan, Hispanic, Black, Asian, White, etc.

**FTE** - Full-time equivalent - Typically used as a standardized measure for the number of SCH to account for part-time enrollment and/or enrollment greater than full-time.

**Full/Part** – Short for Full-time/Part-Time which also includes a sub-grouping of UG and GR.

Values: Full-Time UG, Full-Time GR, Part-Time GR, Part-Time GR

**Gender** – Self-identified gender of student. For reporting purposes, we’re limited to two options.

Values: Female(F), Male(M)

**Level** – Class grouping

Values: Undergraduate, Master’s, Doctoral

**Major** – Field of study.

Values: Law, Finance, Biology, Sociology, Political Science, Educational Leadership, etc.

**School** - Academic college/school housing a course or group of courses.

Values: School of Liberal Arts and Sciences, School of Business, College of Law, etc.

**Semester** – Refers to the academic term.

Values: Fall, Spring, Summer

## Degrees Awarded

**Academic Plan** – The academic program associated to the student.

Values: DACCT-BBA, DPSYC-BA, DCRJS-BS, DGNBU-BBA, etc.

**CIP Code** – Classification of instructional program.

**Ethnicity** – Based on IPEDS ethnicity classification.

Values: American Indian or Alaskan, Hispanic, Black, Asian, White Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander, Unknown, Two or More, etc.

**Degree Level** – Refers to the level of the degree being awarded.

Values: Bachelor's, Master's, Doctoral

**Degree** – Refers to the type of degree being rewarded.

Values: BBA, BA, BS, BAAS, JD, MBA, MED, MS

**Gender** – Self-identified gender of student. For reporting purposes, we're limited to two options.

Values: Female(F), Male(M)

**Major** – Field of study.

Values: Law, Finance, Biology, Sociology, Political Science, Educational Leadership, etc.

**School** - Academic college/school housing a course or group of courses.

Values: School of Liberal Arts and Sciences, School of Business, College of Law, etc.

**Term Awarded** – Refers to the academic term to which the degree was awarded.

Values: Fall, Spring, Summer

## Retention and Graduation

**Attrition Rate** – the percentage of students in the initial cohort who have not returned re-enrolled at UNT Dallas in a subsequent semester (Fall).

**Cumulative Graduation** – calculates the cumulative number of students who have graduated or received a degree starting from the time of the initial cohort up until the specified year and semester.

**Graduation Rate** – the percentage of students in the initial cohort who graduated or had a degree awarded to them.

**Retention Rate** – the percentage of students in the initial cohort who enrolled at UNT Dallas in a subsequent Fall semester.

## Daily Enrollment and SCH

**Admit Type** – Admission categories used for reporting which reflect a student’s status upon entry in the specified term/semester.

Values: 1<sup>st</sup> Time in College (FTIC), Continuing, New UG Trans, New GRAD, Transient, etc.

**Class** - Student level of last application available for a given fall admit term.

Values: Freshman, Sophomore, Junior, Senior, Master’s, Doctoral.

**Ethnicity** – Based on IPEDS ethnicity classification.

Values: American Indian or Alaskan, Hispanic, Black, Asian, White Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander, Unknown, Two or More, International.

**Full/Part** – Short for Full-time/Part-Time which also includes a sub-grouping of UG (undergraduate) and GR (graduate)

Values: Full-Time UG, Full-Time GR, Part-Time GR, Part-Time GR

**Gender** – Self-identified gender of student. For reporting purposes, we’re limited to two options.

Values: Female(F), Male(M)

**Major** – Field of study.

Values: Law, Finance, Biology, Sociology, Political Science, Educational Leadership, etc.

**School** - Academic college/school housing a course or group of courses.

Values: School of Liberal Arts and Sciences, School of Business, College of Law, etc.

**Semester** – Refers to the academic term.

Values: Fall, Spring, Summer

## Course Enrollment Report

**Cap** – the max enrollment available.

**Catalog Number (Cat)** – usually follows the subject, this references the area of study assigned to a course or group of courses.

Example: ART 1300 – “ART” is the Subject and “1300” is the catalog number.

**Duplicated Enrollment** – is the collective enrollment throughout all courses. Instances where a student enrolls in multiple courses their enrollment is seen as duplicated.

**Enrollment (Enrl)** – the total enrollment of a course.

**Mode** – delivery method of the course.

Values: Face-to-Face, Online, Hybrid

**Session (Sess)** – the session code for a course within a semester indicates its length and duration.

Values: 1, 8W1, 8W2, 5W1, 5W2, etc.

**School** - Academic college/school housing a course or group of courses.

Values: School of Liberal Arts and Sciences, School of Business, College of Law, etc.

**Subject (Subj)** – Course subject. In this case, typically abbreviated to four letters.
