C. Course Change Requests (School of Human Services)

COUN 5300 (Systems Leadership Program in CMHC)

Change effective: AY 2022-2023

Change: Change in Long Title and Course Description

Additional information: The change in course title to COUN 5300 - Organizational Systems and Advanced Ethics in CMHC is requested to reflect new content added to the course. The new content is necessary to meet new licensure requirements in the Texas Behavioral Health Executive Council, and Texas State Board of Examiners of Professional Counselors Rules adopted effective November 19, 2020. In the new rules, in addition to COUN 5100 Ethics course, counseling students in the CMHC track are required to take: an additional course in counselor ethics; to include records management, an overview of business/family law and professional practice, and the study of current Council rules. The new required topics will be taught in the requested new course.

New course description: Principles and practices of counseling mental health focusing on advanced ethics, services, leadership, records management, an overview of business/family law and professional practice, current council rules, program development, and program evaluation. Prerequisite(s): COUN 5290, 5680, and 5710, or departmental consent. Offered: Fall and Spring.

Dean Lacy made a motion to approve the course change requests. Dr. Borges moved to second it. All in favor and none opposed. Motion passed with eight of nine voting. (closed)

Change effective: AY 2022-2023 Change: Required Courses in Program

Additional information: Changing DSCI 3870 Management Science in Gen Business Major Requirement to HGMT 3350 Customer Service Mindset. Removing DSCI 3870 from major requirement because it unusual to have as a major requirement for General Business. Students already receive DSCI 2305 as business core. Adding in HMGT 3350 Customer Service to major requirement. Service is a large component in any field of business and there is no current requirement for a service type of course in either the core or major requirement.

Dean Shumway made a motion to approve the program change request. Dean Perez moved to second it. All in favor and none opposed. Motion passed with eight of nine voting. (closed)
