Part 2

Before approval of the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs and enrollment by the Registrar, a Proposal must be submitted. The proposal should be attached to this form. Upon completion of Part 1 and attachment of the Proposal, this form should be submitted to the Associate Dean of Academic Affairs. Sending it via email attachment is fine.

The proposal must contain the following:

<u>Topic</u>. A statement (at least 200 words in length) outlining the proposed topic for study and why the topic merits study. The proposed topic must be a well-articulated question, thesis, or theme that requires substantial research, analysis and synthesis.

<u>Statement of interests and objectives</u>. A statement of the reasons for the student's interest in the topic and his or her objectives in pursuing the independent study.

<u>Timeline</u>: Anticipated timeline for drafts and final paper, and any other dates relevant to the project.

Approval by Associate Dean for Academic Affairs

From Independent Study Process and Guidelines: "The Dean of Academic Affairs must approve the Independent Study proposal prior to registration. Approval will be based on (1) whether the student's record demonstrates self-motivation and responsibility, (2) whether the student's academic record demonstrates sufficient mastery of the skills and concepts necessary for successful completion of an independent writing project of this sort, (3) whether the independent study satisfies the requirements set forth above; and (4) whether the student has identified a faculty member qualified by area and available to oversee the Independent Study."
